Once an extensive analysis of the SECNAVCORB Organization and its systems is completed, Telophase will then develop a concrete plan to re-engineer the SECNAVCORB functionally; and technically, a detailed road-map to successfully implement a total enterprise solution.

It is the vision of the Director of SECNAVCORB to build a system that will provide a portal solution. It is best described as: A modular, integrated, web based system to receive, process, manage, and track cases related to the referral of service personnel to the Disability Evaluation System (DES), applications for combat related special compensation (CRSC) benefits, applications for changes to awarded confinement (i.e., clemency or parole), applications for changes to military records, discharges, medical records, legal issues, and records of trial.
